EDITOR'S NOTE

Students should give careful attention to the alternative fingerings of certain singlenote scales and of all scales in double thirds—indicated in *Malies*. In the single-note scales the difference is merely in the position of groups, but in the double third scales the alternative fingering is founded on a principle which differs fundamentally from that of the "standard" fingering.

No recommendation is given, as a decision should be based on a trial and knowledge of both systems, influenced in many cases by the conformation of the hand. It should be possible, with a normal hand, to achieve equally satisfactory results with either.
