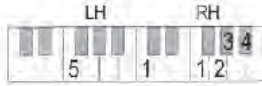

 The LH uses perfect 5ths and moves often, while the RH stays in the F Minor 5 finger pattern.

Practice Suggestions:
 Get comfortable with the F Minor pattern first (F G A B C). Next, learn the RH alone.
