AL CAIOLA is one of the most widely admired young "pop" guitarists in the business, famous as a dazzling solo performer, yet equally adept at providing a background in exquisite taste.

He began his career shortly after concluding his tour of duty with the United States Marine Corps in World War II. Following his studies of composition, theory and harmony at the

New Jersey Music College, he was engaged by CBS Radio and participated in many important network shows, including Arthur Godfrey, Talent Scouts, Ed Sullivan, Steve Allen, and the Armed Forces Radio Show with Raymond Paige.

As featured guitarist he has recorded extensively with famed conductors André Kostelanetz, Percy Faith, Morton Gould, Mitch Miller, and Hugo Winterhalter; and he has supported singers Tony Bennett, Frankie Laine, Rosemary Clooney, and Frankie Avalon in some of their greatest recorded hits. As a recording artist in his own right, Al Caiola has done many albums and singles for United Artists Records which have enjoyed enormous success.

In the present folio of imaginative guitar stylings there is revealed still another side of this gifted musician. He has somehow managed to produce arrangements which lie well within the grasp of the average competent guitarist, yet which scintillate with that certain flair best described as the "Caiola Sound."
